




ONE-COLOUR CALM




COOL AND CALMING

PAINTING OUTSIDE THE BOX

Using the Dulux Colours of the Year, the indigo blues of 2026, and the on-trend colour stories, it's easy to put your own creative stamp on a space. Here are some ideas for fun and quick paint projects, using the Free colour palette, that will bring any room to life.





BEYOND THE COLOUR BLOCK

Colour-blocking is easy to do and very effective.
Choose complementary or contrasting shades depending on the effect you want and outline blocks on the wall with masking tape before you start painting. Let your first colour dry before starting the second and, to get a crisp border, remove the tape while the paint is still wet.



CONNECT WITH COLOUR

Play with the architectural details of your room and don't feel you have to stick within the lines. Here, a dramatic panel of ochre stretches across the wall and cabinet to create a striking doorway feature. The colour is also picked up in the room beyond to make the two spaces feel connected.

PLAY WITH PROPORTION

Don't feel restricted by the dimensions of a small window. Make it feel bigger by extending colour from the frame to the surrounding wall. Here, a bold panel of colour stretches from the window up to the ceiling to create an interesting and offbeat feature above the worktop. It also cleverly draws the eye towards the view outside.



PAINT CREATIVE

Soften the linear feel of walls and doorways by painting beyond their borders. As well as making the hard edges of a room 'disappear', this technique gives a graphic, contemporary result. Here, a brilliant yellow is combined with our Free Groove™ to create a perfectly balanced bedroom.
